To add to the festivities, all decorated homes will be entered into a raffle drawing for a prize giveaway - courtesy of your fellow neighbors! The winner will be selected at random and prize delivered November 1st.

You've Been Booed!

Booing is a Halloween tradition that involves secretly getting and gifting goodies with neighbors, spreading fun in the community during the month of October! "You've Been Booed" is also back, so that adults can get in on the fun this year as well!

Here are the rules:

1. Make up two bags or baskets of Halloween-themed goodies. Print two "You've Been Booed" and two "We've Been Booed" signs (free templates can be found online). Include a "We've Been Booed" sign inside each bag or basket and stick a "You've Been Booed" sign on the outside front of each.
2. Decide on two neighbors who you want to Boo. It should be someone who hasn't previously been booed (you'll know who, as there should be a We've Been Booed sign up at their home). Deliver your gift in secret!
3. If you've been booed, place the We've Been Booed sign in your front window or door where it can easily be seen. Enjoy the treats you received!
4. Start with step 1 above to keep the goodwill going.
